Being a Vessel

Being a Vessel is series of paintings, ceramics, moving image and live performance that I created from a place of being deeply inspired and intrigued by other artists, writers, architects or designers. I make these works as a way to translate inspiration into my own visual language creating memories and reminders of art works that have uplifted and inspired me, but also to explore what it means to be inspired and influenced by others.

The ceramics for *Being a Vessel* are made on the potter's wheel using traditional techniques and materials. They are dipped into or painted with a white clay slip, some are incised and painted with underglaze colours. Using digital ceramic transfer prints I add another layer of text and images onto the earthenware vases. I am working with this technique on ceramics dedicated to Eva Zeisel, Gae Aulenti, Trisha Brown, Cora Sandel, Ray Eames and Nasreen Mohamedi.

The initial piece of *Being a Vessel* was the video *Anna*, an homage to artist Anna Oppermann combining dance, painting and collage.

Currently, I am developing this working process further by moving it out of the studio and performing an homage in the exhibition space. During the performance I work with dance movements, text and pastel colours to evoke, embody and paint a large format work on paper dedicated to an artist or writer.
